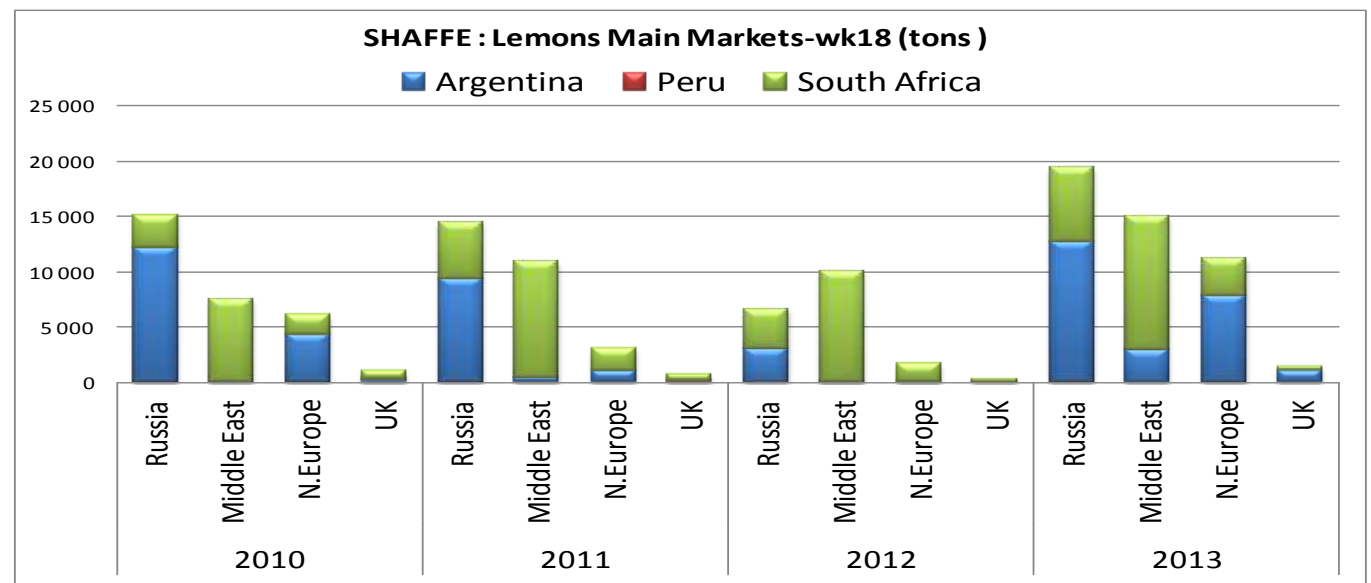
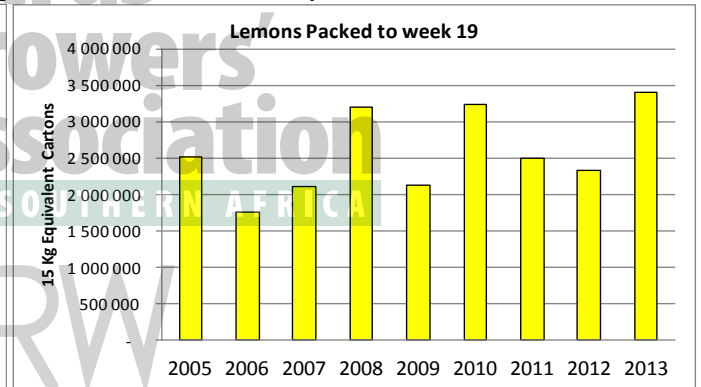
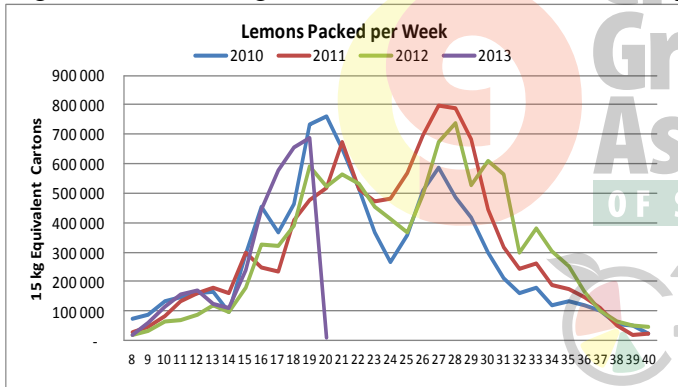
GRAPEFRUIT

The packing of grapefruit is at the highest tempo since 2005. The Grapefruit Focus Group noted that the packing could finish earlier. Market distribution is similar to last year.



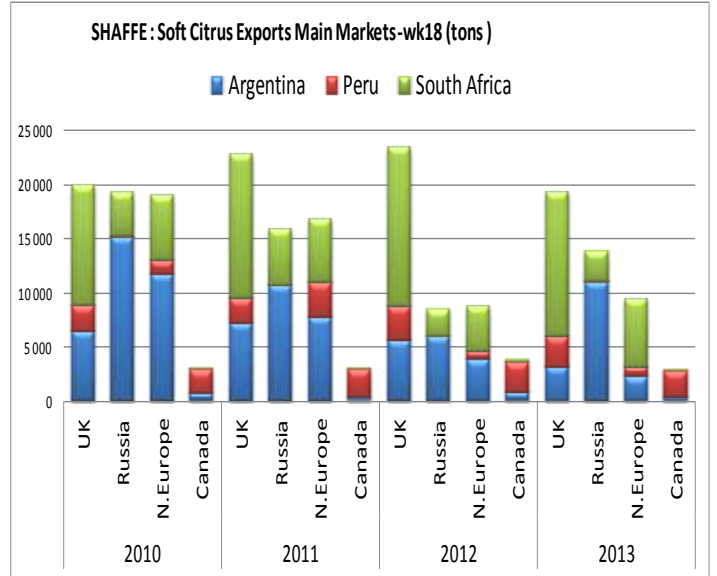
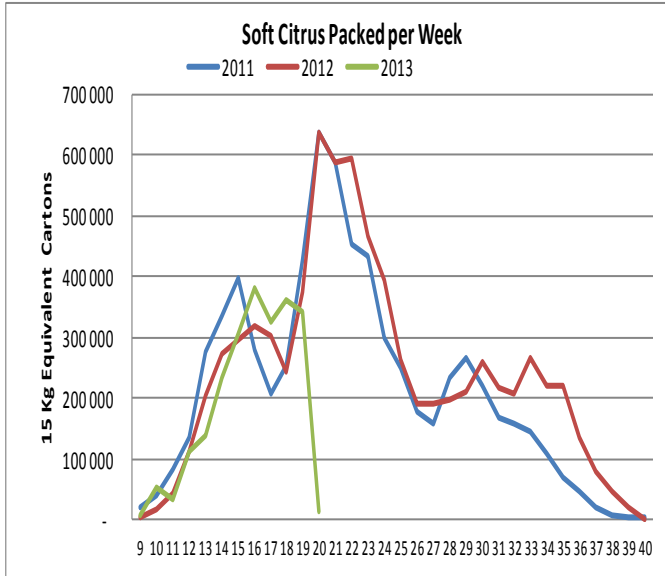
LEMONS
