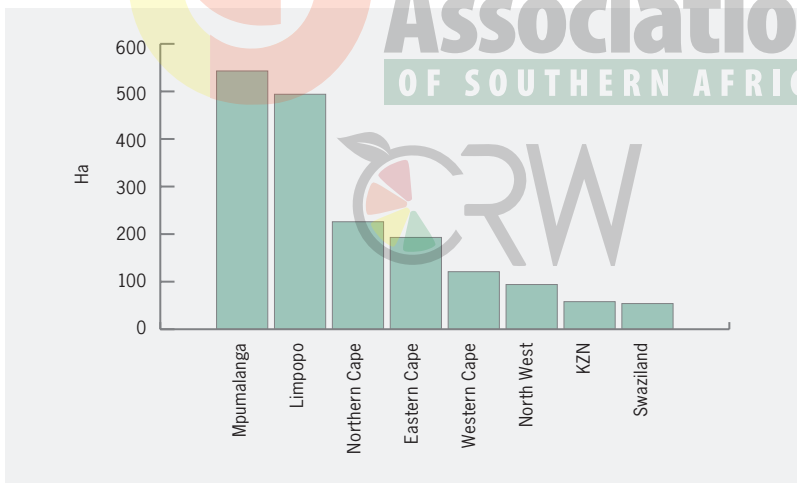

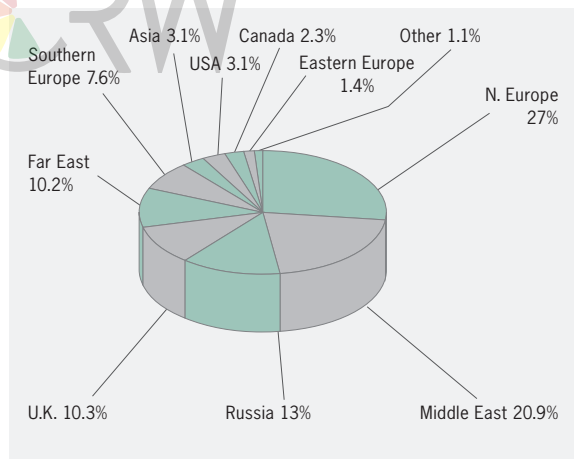
PRODUCTION SECTORS VOLUME 2010

ALL CITRUS MAJOR EXPORT DESTINATIONS 2010

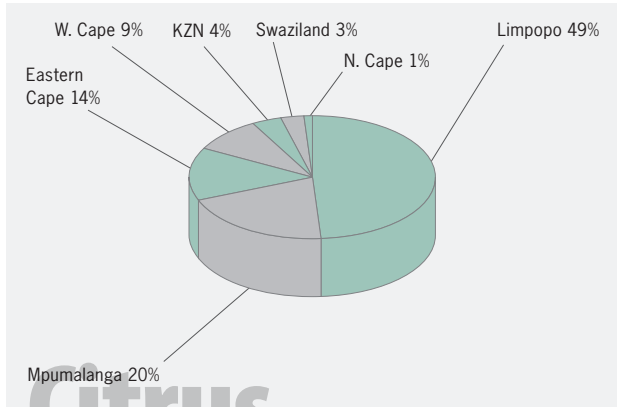

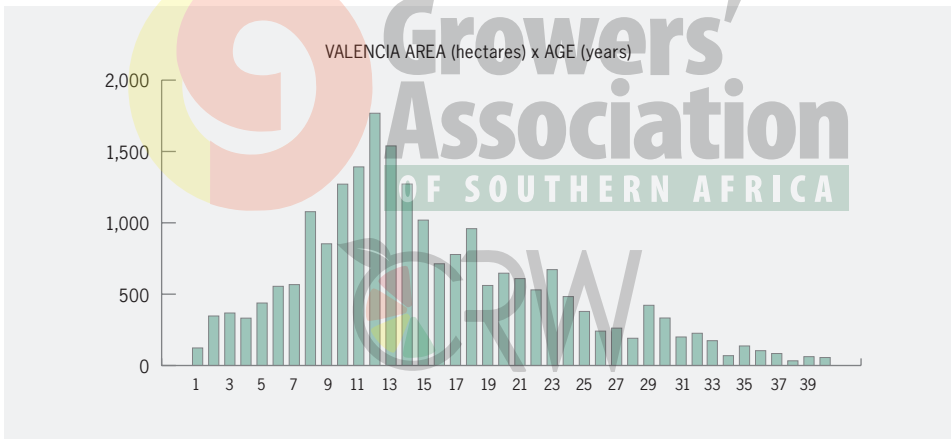

AGE CLASS DISTRIBUTION: VALENCIAS

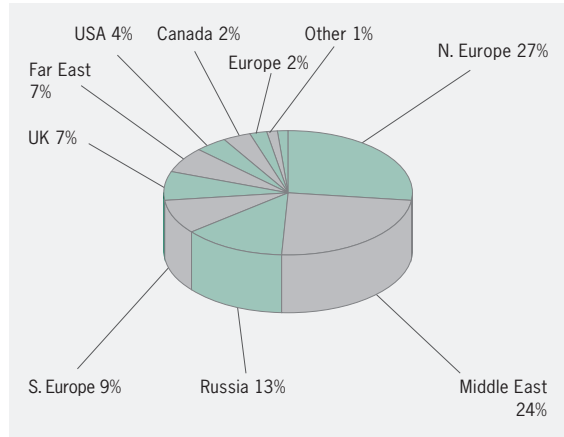

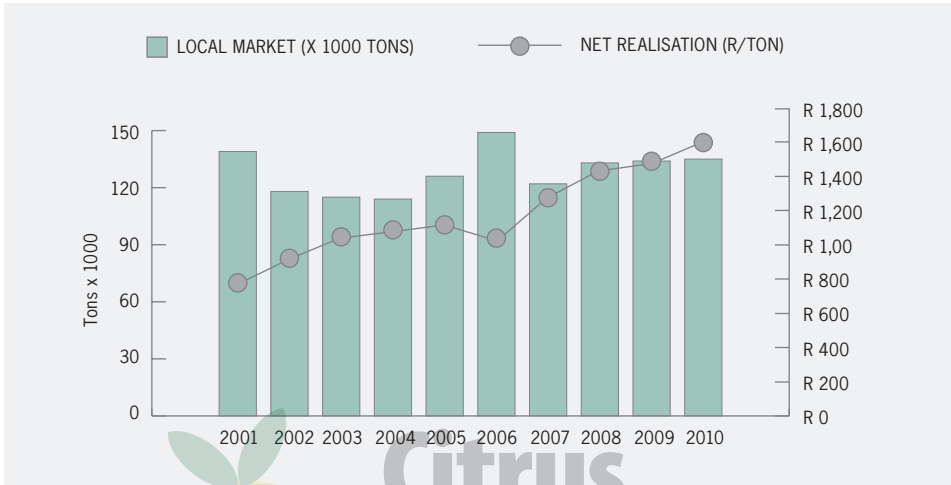
NAVELS SHIPPED 2010



VALENCIAS SHIPPED 2010

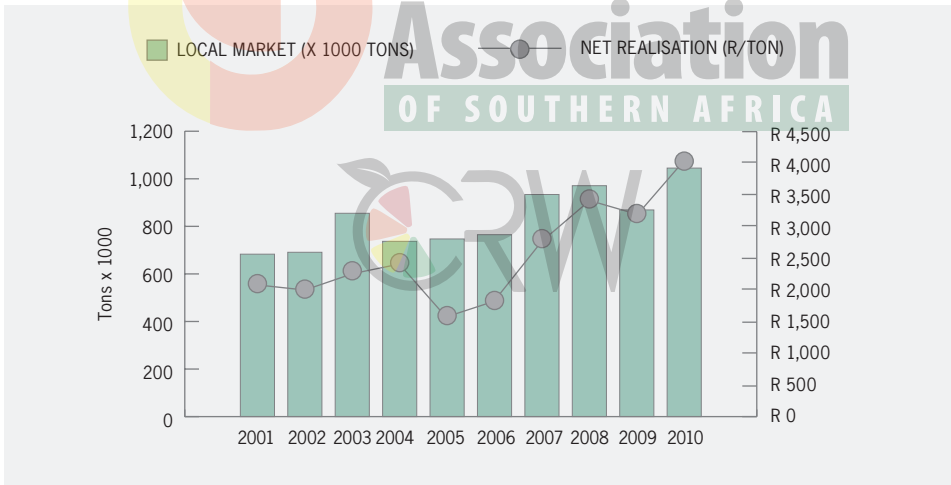

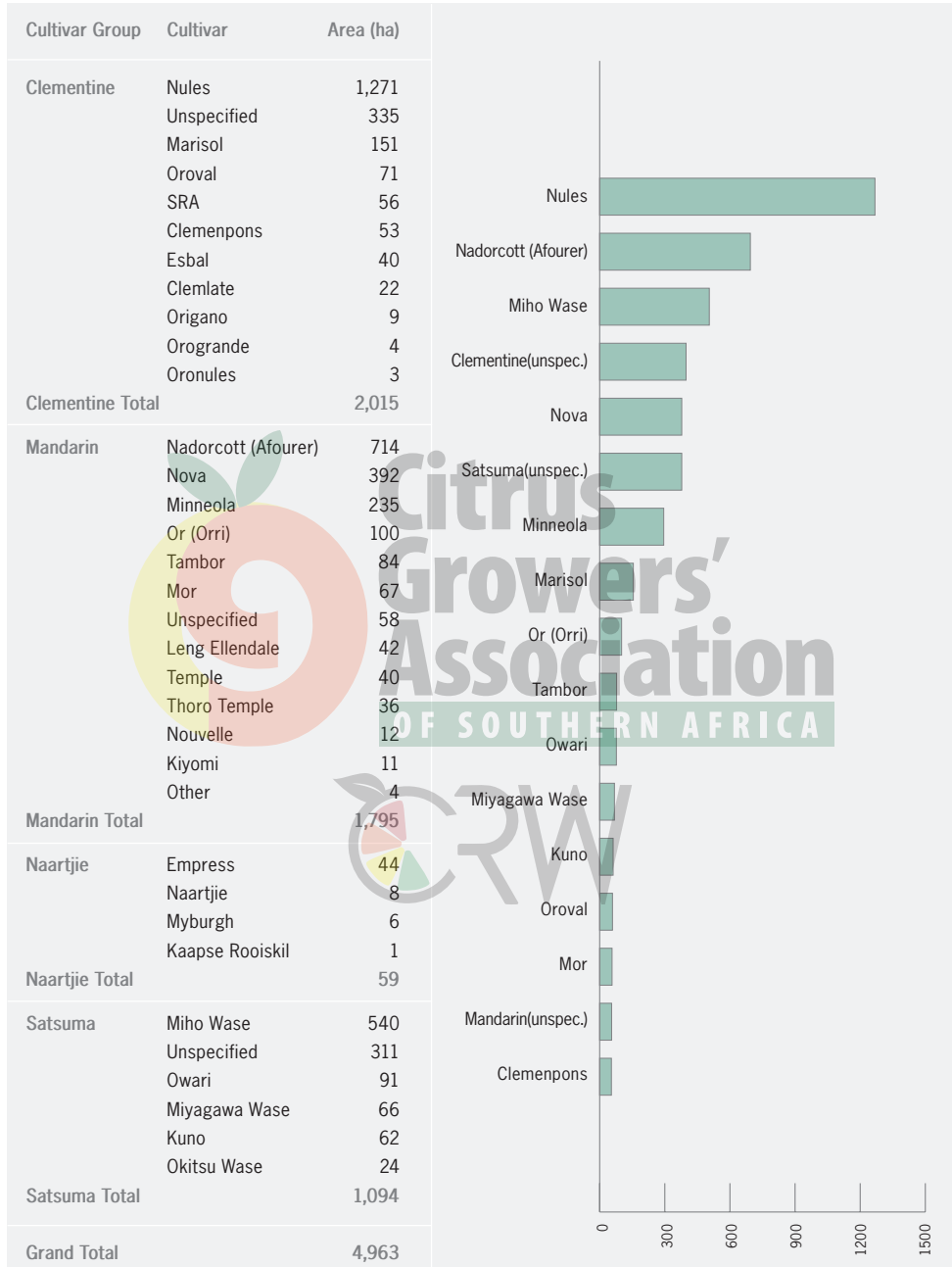

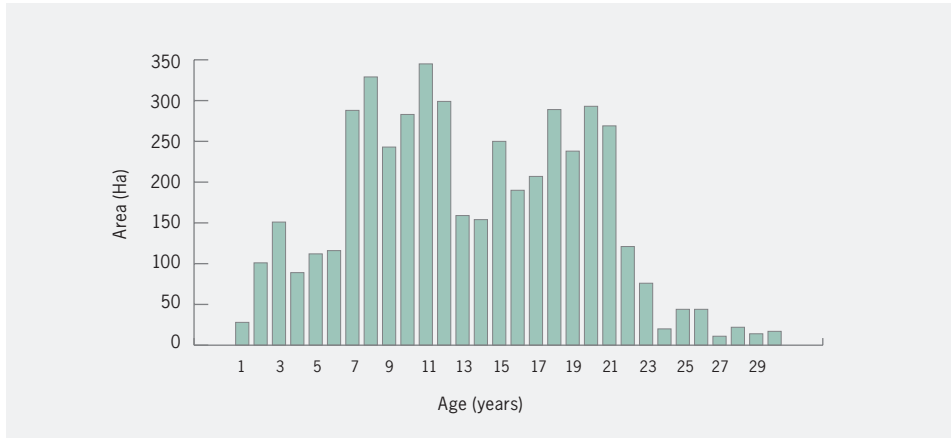

AGE DISTRIBUTION SOFT CITRUS



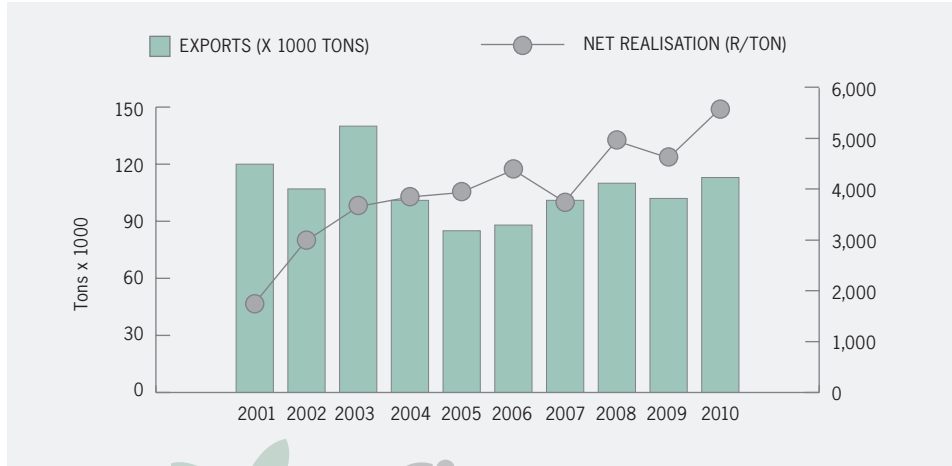

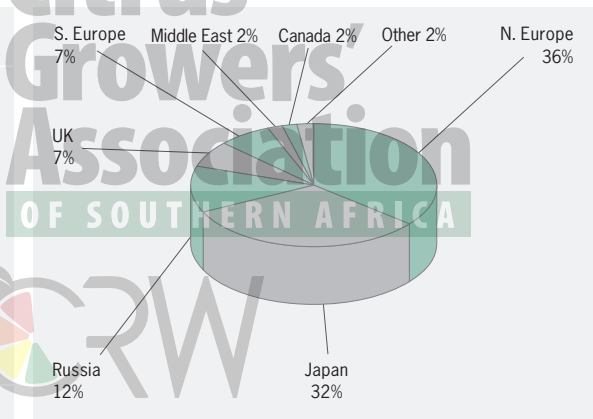

GRAPEFRUIT SHIPPED 2010



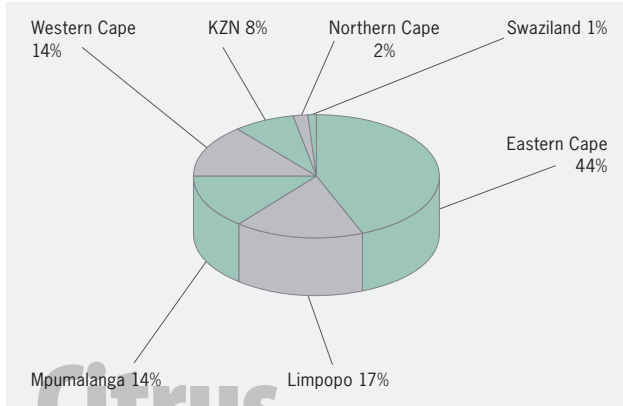

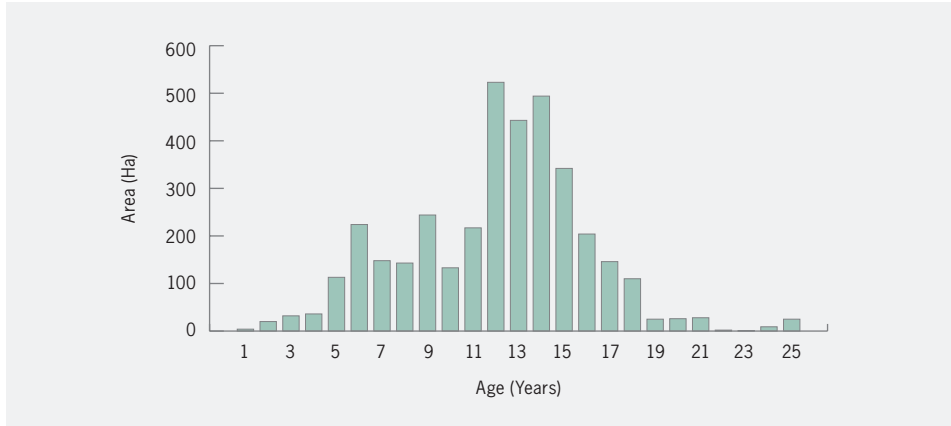

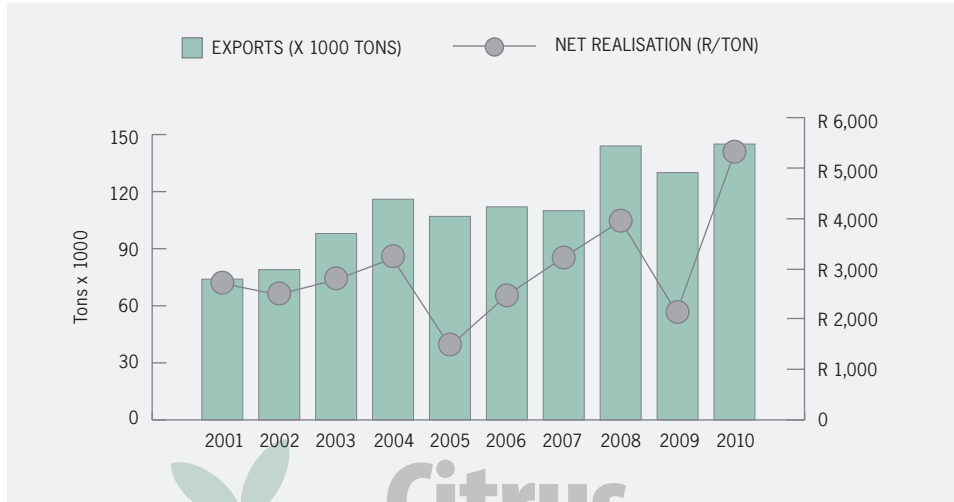
LEMONS MAJOR EXPORT DESTINATIONS 2010

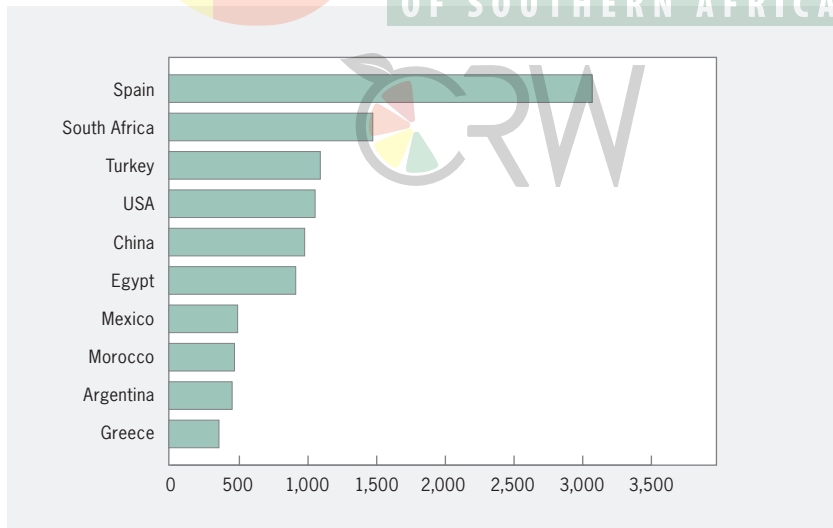

WORLD FRESH CITRUS PRODUCTION 2009/10 (thousand tons)



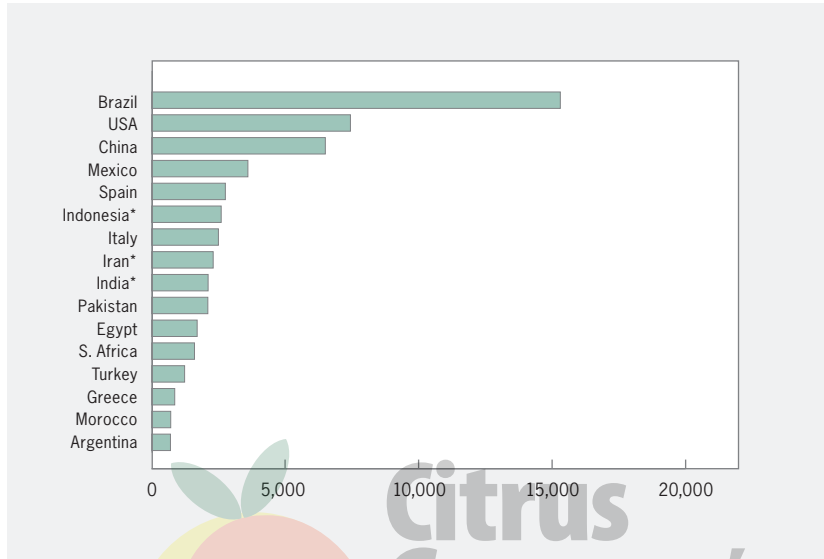

WORLD FRESH CITRUS EXPORTS 2009/10 (thousand tons)



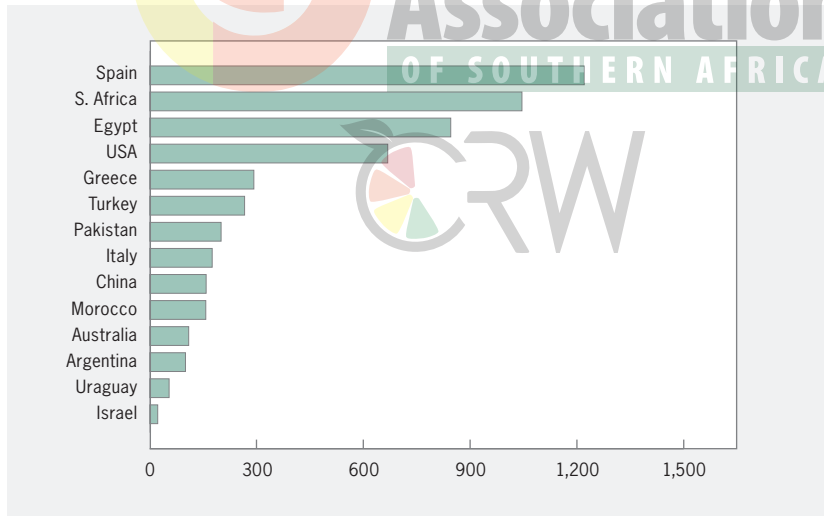

WORLD ORANGE PRODUCTION 2009/10 (thousand tons)



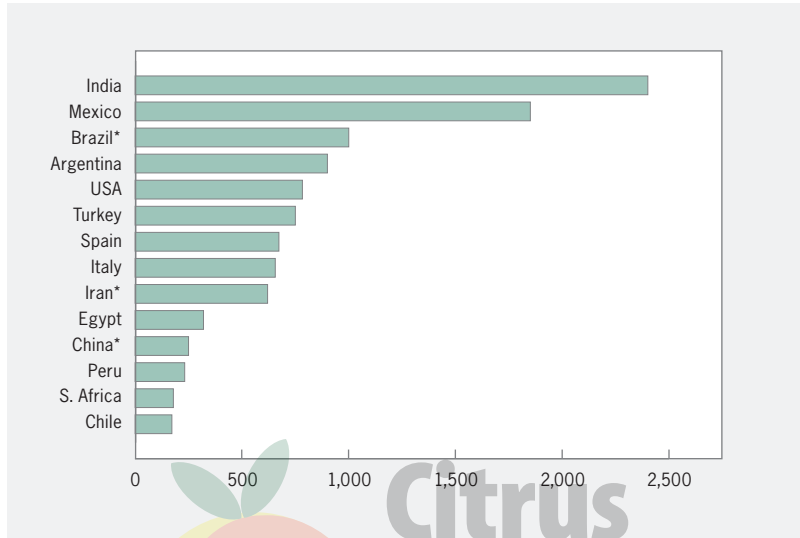

WORLD ORANGE EXPORTS 2009/10 (thousand tons)



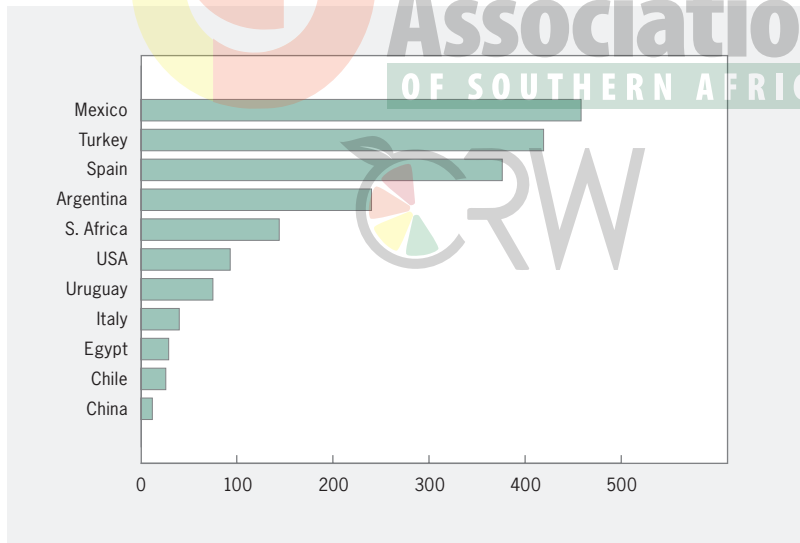

WORLD LEMON PRODUCTION 2009/10 (thousand tons)



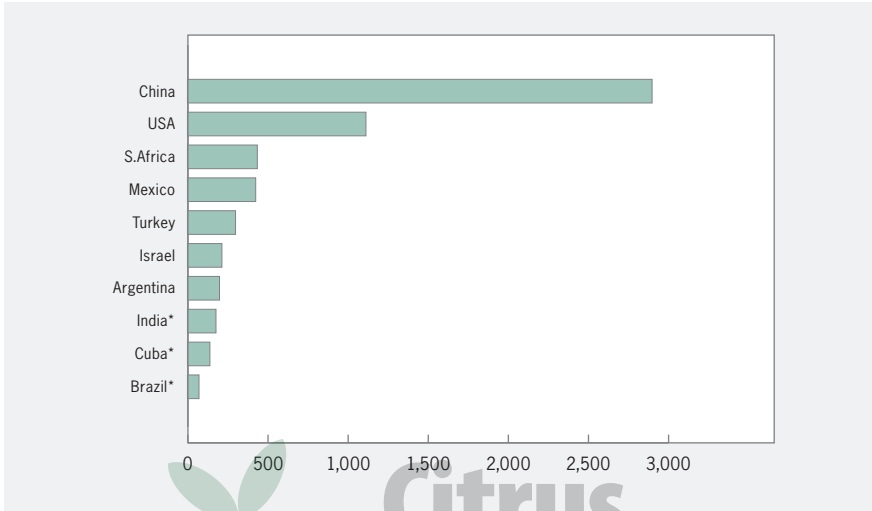

WORLD LEMON EXPORTS 2009/10 (thousand tons)

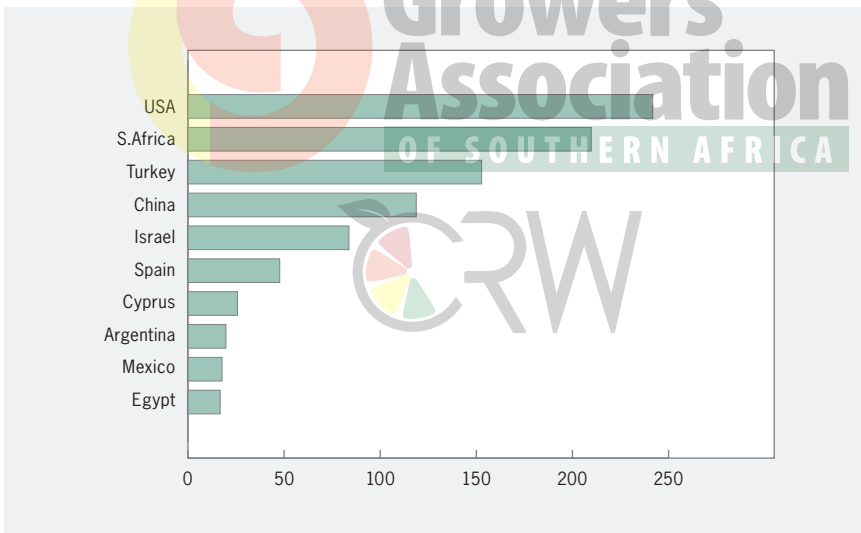

WORLD GRAPEFRUIT PRODUCTION 2009/10 (thousand tons)

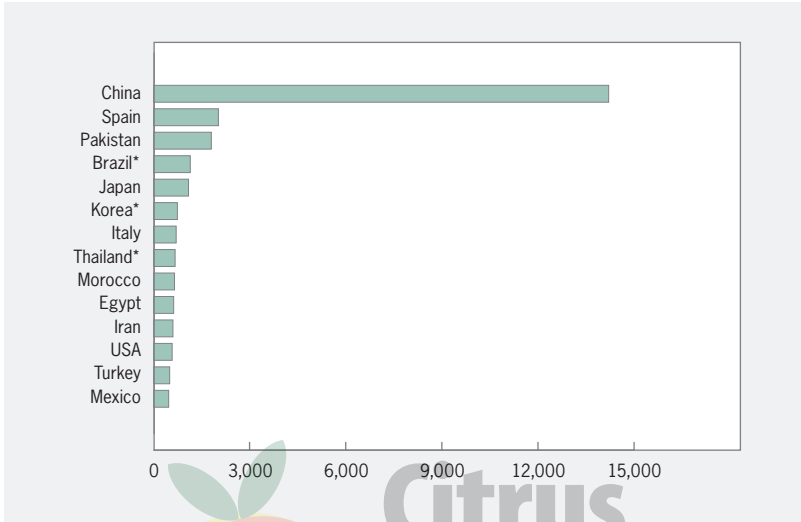


WORLD GRAPEFRUIT EXPORTS 2009/10 (thousand tons)

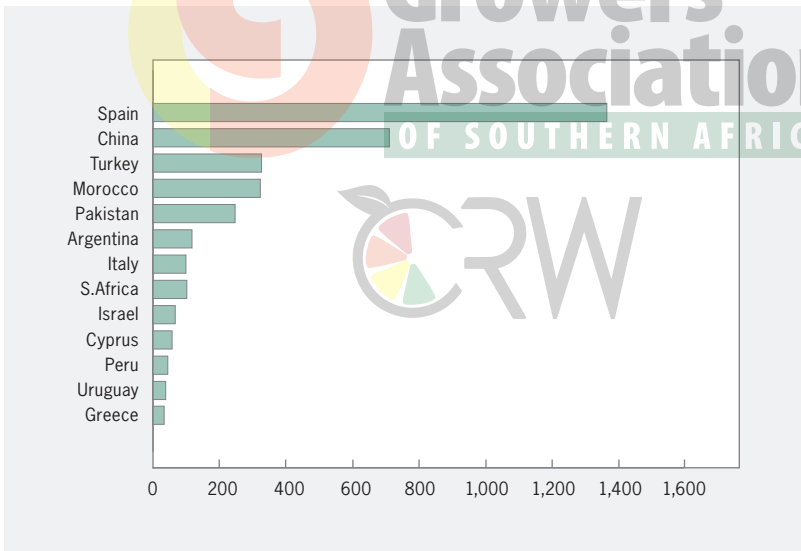








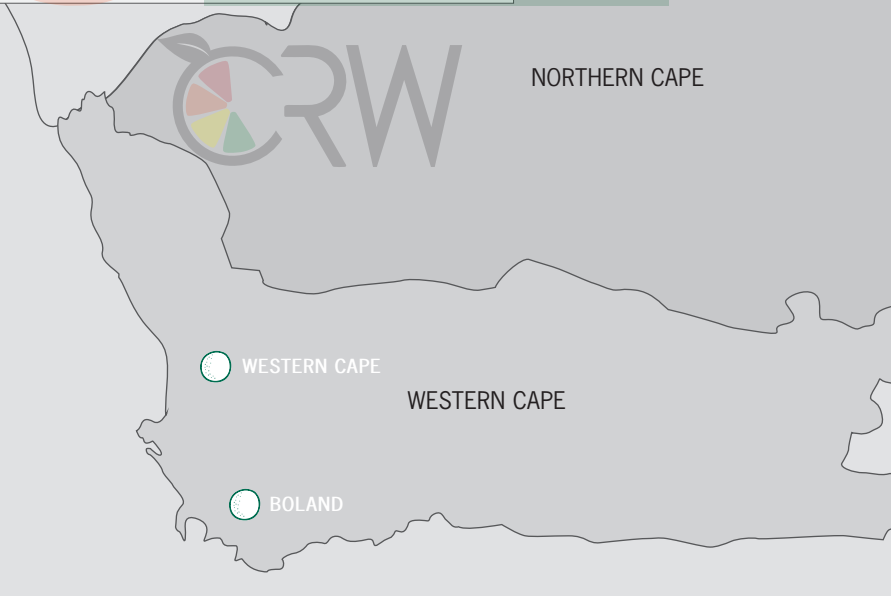
WORLD SOFT CITRUS EXPORTS 2009/10 (thousand tons)

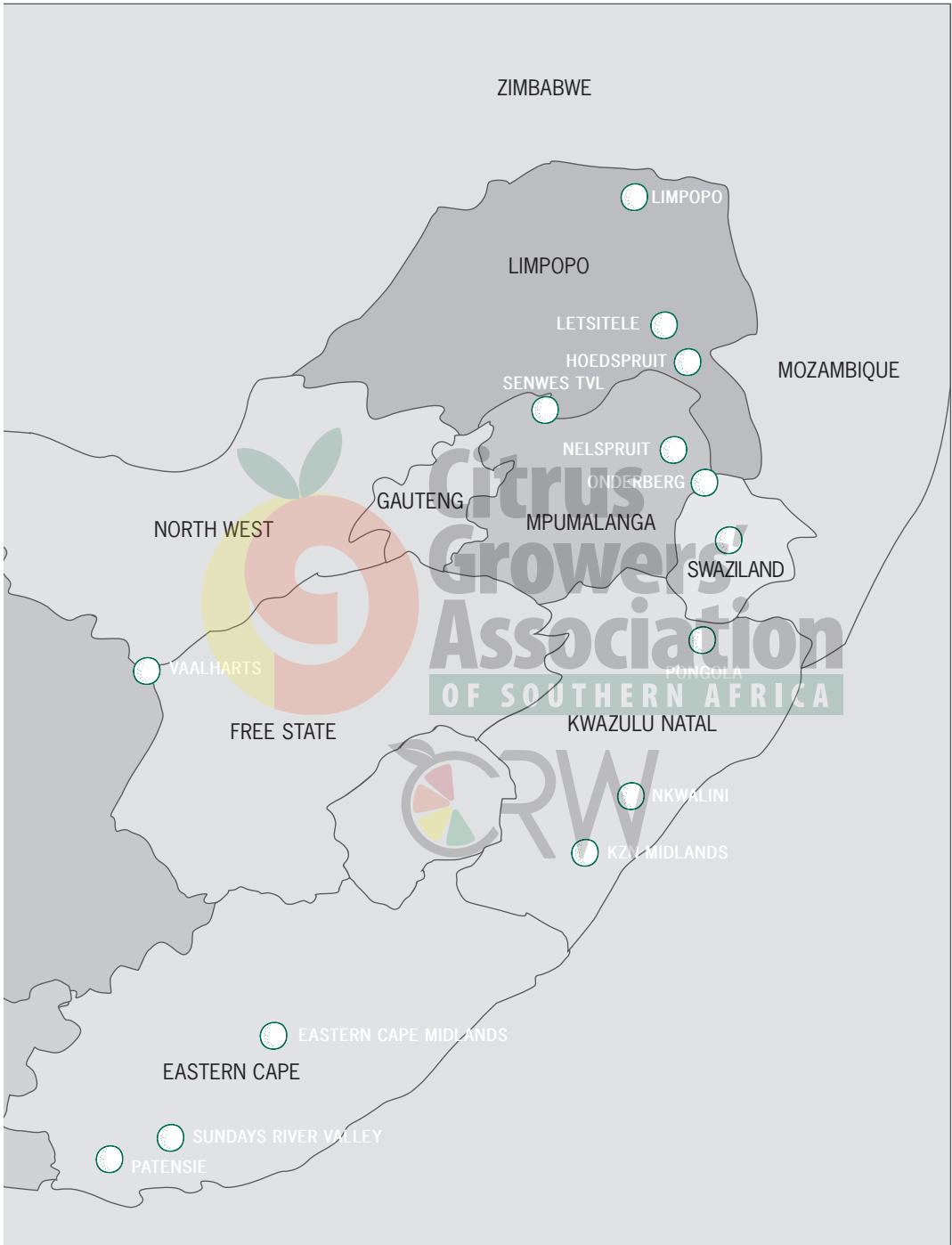

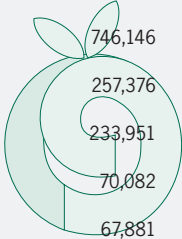
